

2011 PUBLIC HEARINGS

Taxing Authorities must hold two public hearings to adopt a millage rate and budget. The first or “tentative” hearing (final hearing for School Districts) is advertised on the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes (TRIM Notice), which is mailed by the Property Appraiser.

The TRIM Notice is the only advertisement required for the tentative hearing. The Final Hearing is advertised by the taxing authority.

At each hearing, the governing body will hear comments about the proposed tax increase or decrease and explain reasons for the proposed increase/decrease over/under the rolled-back rate. The public can speak and ask questions before the governing body adopts any measures.
